



S1 Option Phase

S1 Option Phase

(Submission of S1 options)

➤ Mode 1 - Submission through S1-IS

- ❑ Link to S1-IS via S1 website

www.moe.gov.sg/admissions/secondary-one-posting-exercise

- ❑ System availability: 24-hour from **11 am on the first day until 3pm on last day of S1 Option Phase (Singapore Time)**.
- ❑ Primary schools to provide PCs (with Internet access) and printers for parents to use during S1 Option Phase.
- ❑ Refer to S1-IS step-by-step guide in S1 Information Booklet and S1 website.



S1 Option Phase

(Submission of S1 options)

➤ Mode 2 - Submission through Primary School

- Parents may ask schools to submit S1 Options:
 - 1st day: 11am to 3pm
 - 2nd to last day: 9am to 3pm
 - Day after submission closes: 9am – 12noon (only for new submission of school choices)
- School staff to access S1-IS using SingPass.
- Print 2 copies of Verification Slip (VS) to be signed by parent – 1 copy for schools to retain for audit purposes and 1 copy for parent.
- Refer to S1-IS step-by-step school user guide for details.
- Parents not in Singapore may authorise a proxy to submit S1 options, on their behalf. The proxy form can be found in the S1 Information Booklet and S1 website.



S1 Option Phase (Amendment of S1 options)

➤ Amendments to S1 options:

- Parents can amend submitted S1 options via S1-IS once only.
- Parents who wish to amend again are to approach primary school for assistance.
- Amendments not allowed after end of S1 Option Phase.

➤ Non-Submission of S1 options:

- Students will be posted to a school with vacancy near home.

School Posting Phase – How does S1 posting work?

Students are posted to secondary schools based on merit. This means that students with a higher PSLE score will be posted to their school of choice before another student with a lower score. Vacancies are filled up by students with higher scores first.



Amanda's School Choices

1 : School A	4 : School D
2 : School B	5 : School E
3 : School C	6 : School F

STEP 1

Amanda is considered for her first choice (A). If there are other students with higher PSLE scores than Amanda, they will be posted before her. If there are still vacancies in School A, she will be posted to the school.



STEP 2

If there are no more vacancies in her first choice (A), she will be considered for the next school, based on the order of her school choices (B, C, D, E and F) until she is posted to a secondary school with vacancies.



STEP 3

If all vacancies in Amanda's school choices (A to F) are filled with students who have better PSLE scores, she will be posted to a school near her home, which has vacancies.
